Dear Parent / Carer,

To help prepare students for their GCSE maths exam we have been setting and marking a specimen exam paper each fortnight.

There are two papers left to be completed, the first of which has been handed out this week:

The vast majority of students have engaged very well with this and are making progress as a result. Once students have completed a paper, it is marked by the teacher and a QR code is provided for students to watch a video and review questions specified by their teacher questions where some easy gains can be made. This feedback task is really important. Although it takes less time than completing the paper, there is the potential to make some really big gains.

I would be grateful if you could continue to support your child in completing these papers, **and in particular the feedback tasks.**
