I would like to inform you about the importance of your child's upcoming internal exams that are taking place in the week commencing Monday 07 June 2021.

This set of upcoming internal exams will be based on curriculum content covered throughout Year 7 so far and will inform your child's progress to date. The scores achieved will provide a set of robust data and results, which will be analysed to inform your child's current attainment and progress towards achieving their academic targets in each subject. The results of these examinations will form part of your child's next progress report. It is essential that **all exams** are approached with the upmost care and diligence.

In view of this, **attendance** at each of these exams is essential. It is also vital that your child prepares for each of these exams correctly and that they arrive to each exam punctually, having completed a suitable amount of revision and preparation at home. Students must also ensure that they are appropriately equipped and organised with all necessary tools and equipment to complete each exam, to the best of their ability.

Throughout this set of internal exams, students will be examined in the following subjects; **English, Maths, Science, MFL (French or German), History, Geography, Design and Technology and RPE.**

All exams will take place in their usual timetabled lesson periods. Students will be informed by their subject teachers in lessons prior to half term, as to the specific date and time of each exam, taking place during their internal examination period, which students will record in their planner.

Year 7 Internal Exam Information 2021 – 7-11 June 2021

Students will sit exams in the subjects listed below.

Exams will take place during timetabled lessons w/c 7 June 2021.



Subject	Key topics / content and/or skills to be examined		Revision Tools / Resources to be used
English	The Year 7 English assessment will be focused on creative writing. Students will use stimuli relating to the spine text they are currently studying to produce a piece of narrative writing. They will need to ensure that they are showing off their creative writing skills: selecting appropriate vocabulary to build detail in their writing; building in language features such as similes, metaphors and personification; using sensory description in their writing; pacing and ordering their writing to create tension and excitement for their reader.		Students should use their exercise books and revision resources on Firefly to prepare for this exam.
Maths	Topics to be covered: - Understand notation for angles - Draw and measure line and angles - Classify angles - Identify and draw parallel and perpendicular lines - Finding angles in shapes triangles and quadrilaterals - Types of shapes (triangles, quadrilaterals and polygons) - Construct triangles (SSS, SAS, ASA) - Draw and interpret pie charts - Know apply basic angle facts (Angles at a point, straight line, Parallel lines).		Students should use their exercise books, revision resources on Firefly and Dr Frost Maths to prepare for this exam.
French / German	French Topics to be covered: - - C'est parti - Famille et copains - Chez moi	German Topics to be covered: - - Hallo - Familie und Freunde - Freizeit	Students should use their exercise book to revise key vocabulary to prepare for this exam.
Science	Topics to be covered: - Waves - sound - Genes - Organisms - Ecosystems - Matter - Earth - Forces		Students should use their exercise books, revision resources on Firefly, EduCake, and the BBC KS3 bitesize website for their revision
History	Topics to be covered: Norman Conquest: - Battle of Hastings, Outcome of the Battle of Hastings, Claimants on the throne Norman Control: - Castles, William the Conqueror, the Harrying of the North		Students should use their exercise book, revision sheets, resources of Firefly and links on the BBC bitesize website to prepare.

Geography	Topics to be covered: • Map skills • Settlement (types of settlement e.g. nuclear, linear and dispersed) • Ecosystems – the location of ecosystems and animal/plant adaptations.	Students should use their exercise books, resources set on Firefly and links on the BBC bitesize website to prepare.
RPE	Topics to be covered: • Key knowledge terms • Christian and Hindu creation stories • The Big Bang Theory • Why is learning about religion important? • Shirk • The Guru Granth Sahib	Students should use the A3 knowledge organiser that you will complete in class and their exercise book to prepare.
Design & Technology	The Y7 exam will cover skills and knowledge which has been taught since September. This will include what was delivered during remote learning. Topic areas will include: • Sustainability • Marking out and measuring • Selecting appropriate tools/equipment • Health and Safety • Hygiene • Cooking skills • Farm to Fork • Perspective drawing • Textiles skills Students will not be required to complete any questions for areas of DT they have not yet studied, e.g. if they haven't yet studied Food Technology, they will not need to answer questions on this topic.	Students should use their work on Microsoft Teams as well as BBC Bitesize to prepare.



Year 7 Internal Exams - Revision Guidance and Strategies



Before you start your Revision

- Ensure that you have got all necessary class notes, exercise books and resources that you need, as well as access to Firefly.
- Ask your teacher what topics you need to revise for each exam.
- Plan your revision in advance and decide upon appropriate revision strategies.

During Revision

- Revise in a quiet place away from distractions.
- Revise in small chunks - 30 minutes, followed by a 5-10-minute break.
- Use a range of techniques including:
 - Reading through class work / revision resources
 - Creating summary notes
 - Highlighting key words and spellings
 - Creating Posters / Mind maps for topics
 - Creating Revision Cards with Key Facts on for each topic
 - Use revision websites such as BBC Bitesize, EduCake, Kahoot and Dr Frost Maths to look over and answer questions on key topics.
 - Working with a partner – ask recall questions on key topics
 - Workington Academy Firefly also has a range of subject specific resources for key topics.

Before the Exam

- Get a good night's sleep the night before each exam, (at least 8 hours)
- Eat a suitable breakfast
- Arrive on time
- Bring all necessary equipment with you required for each exam
- Think positive and stay focused.

During the Exam

- Follow instructions and remain in silence at all times during the exam.
- Listen to and read exam instructions carefully
- Do not rush, take your time when reading and answering questions
- Attempt all questions
- Read each question twice
- Highlight or underline key words in long answer questions
- Look at the number of marks available per question and make enough points to cover the amount of marks available.
- Plan answers to longer questions
- If you finish the exam before the time period is over, read through your answers carefully and make any necessary changes.

- Colouring pencils

- Compass
